CREDIT COURSES

- Tuesdays and Thursdays from September 17, 2019-January 14, 2020 from 6:00 - 9:00 pm. **(FULL AND REPEAT CREDIT)**
- **Civics runs from September 17 – November 7, 2019; Careers runs from November 12, 2019 – January 14, 2020**
- **Please note there is no school: October 24, 2019 (parent/teacher interviews - day school), or December 23, 2019 – January 3, 2020 (Christmas Break)**

ELIGIBILITY

- Current Secondary school students may register if the student obtains a signed permission form from his/her day school Principal or designate. **Adult and Public School Students – please see “How to Register” below.**

ATTENDANCE

- Prompt attendance for each scheduled class is expected. Three absences in a full credit or repeat course, or one and a half absences in a half credit course, may result in withdrawal from the program. Three lates classify as one absence.

FEES

- **Foreign Visa Students: Full and repeat credit course - \$1366.00; Half credit course - \$653.00 each** (cash or certified cheque only), is payable in full at time of registration. Refunds only if we cancel the class.
- Students that damage or vandalise school property will be held responsible for any and all costs associated with their actions.

HOW TO REGISTER

REGISTER IN ONE OF TWO WAYS:

- 1) **ON-LINE REGISTRATION:** Begins Tuesday September 3, 2019 at <http://my.pathtosuccess.ca> Students of the HWCDSB must **Log in** using existing **MyPath** account. Once logged in to MyPath, students must select “School Courses” then “HWCDSB Summer/Night School”, and once there, select the course and preferred location. Adults and Non-HWCDSB students will need to **create** a new account if you haven’t already (BE ACCURATE) and fill out an Online Registration form (<https://via.hwcdb.ca/>). Follow the QRC instructions found on www.stcharles.ca/ns. Bring your signed “Permission to attend” form with you to the first class (Download from www.stcharles.ca).
- 2) **ON-SITE REGISTRATION:** Only if you have NOT registered on-line, you can register at the Night School location of your choice from 6:00 to 8:00 pm on Thursday September 12, 2019. You **MUST** have your signed permission form to register (Download from www.stcharles.ca).

PLEASE NOTE - REPORT CARDS are mailed to the day school you have indicated, make sure this information is correct.

Adults must bring their high school transcript, birth certificate or passport (or Immigration documentation if not a citizen) to register for Credit classes.
