- ♦ Tuesdays and Thursdays from February 9 - April 10, 2012 from 6:00 p.m. - 9:00 p.m. **(UPGRADE)**

### **ELIGIBILITY**

- ♦ Secondary school students may register if:
  - i) The course is unavailable to student at regular day school;
  - ii) The student obtains written permission from his/her day school principal or designate.

### **ATTENDANCE**

Prompt, daily attendance is expected. Students who incur more than 3 absences in a full credit course and 1.5 absences in a half credit or upgrade course will be withdrawn.

### **FEES**

- **Ontario secondary school students:** a book deposit of **\$100.00 (cheque only)** made payable to **St. Charles** is required on the first day of class for most credit courses. The cheque will be returned when the student returns the book.
- **VISA students:** **\$1506.00 for a full credit course** (cash or certified cheque only) or **\$753.00 for an upgrade course**, payable in full at registration. Refunds only for cancelled courses.

### **HOW TO REGISTER**

- **DOWNLOAD A PERMISSION FORM**, which **MUST BE** signed by your principal/designate and register in one of two ways:
- 1) **On-line registration** begins Thursday January 12, 2012 on ContinuEd <http://coned.hwcdsb.ca>. Create an account (BE ACCURATE) If you have a confirmed on-line registration, bring your signed permission form with you to the first night of class (February 9th).
- 2) **On-site registration** will be held at St. Jean de Brebeuf – 200 Acadia Dr. from 6:00 to 8:00 pm on February 2 & 7 for individuals who have **NOT registered on-line. You must bring your signed permission form with you to register.**

## ONTARIO SECONDARY SCHOOL LITERACY

OLC 4O1 is the new Ontario Secondary School Literacy Course (OSSLC) and is offered to students who have had one (1) attempt and did not pass the Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test.

This course is designed to help students with significant gaps in their literacy skills.

Students who have been eligible to write the Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test (OSSLT) at least once and have been unsuccessful, are eligible to take this course to achieve both a Grade 12 credit and their literacy credential for graduation.
